What is Proclamation Dance Company?

Proclamation is an opportunity to be a dancing evangelist! We communicate the Gospel by dancing our stories.

Participating keeps our college and adult dancers in shape and more easily hireable by other companies.

Our High School students gain the experience they need to participate in college dance programs and possibly qualify for dance scholarships.

Proclamation is a wonderful way to add more dance to your life and spend time with friends who love dance as much as you do!

Joyful Soles Company Dancers set the tone for excellence at our studio. They lead, by example, demonstrating a respectful attitude towards Directors, fellow Company members and our studio dancers. Company members are dedicated to pursuing excellence in dance. They arrive prepared for class, give instructors their full attention, apply corrections, follow studio rules and inspire other dancers to do the same.

Our Company Dancers are committed to rehearsals on Monday evenings from 7:00 to 8:30 and additional “Company Only” rehearsals during our production week. Not all dancers are needed at every rehearsal, so we create a rehearsal schedule and post it by the 1st of each month. This allows you to make other plans for the Mondays you are not needed. Please understand that missing a scheduled rehearsal may result in exclusion from a particular dance. *Why would a dancer be excluded?* We create solos, duets, and full Company pieces for our Company Dancers. There is limited time to give instruction for all that needs to be created. Dancers will have one or two rehearsals to learn each piece. Then, we “review” pieces. If dancers miss instruction, they haven't “learned” If they haven't “learned”, they can't “review.”

Proclamation members dancing in The Glass Slipper pay a Company dance fee of \$200.

The Company Production fee pays our Choreographer for the instructional hours needed to create our Company dances.

It also helps cover the cost of additional costuming needed for these extra pieces.

Completed Recommendation and Peer Review forms are due by October 18th

Completed forms should be folded in thirds and taped at both ends or tucked in an envelope, then placed in our tuition box.

Completed forms should not be read by the applicant.

Your Recommendations and Reviews will be shared with our panel of judges and based on that information; audition invitations will be sent.

Audition Date: December 7th 9:30-Noon

For your audition, please complete the attached Audition form and bring it to your audition. You will give this to the judges. Prepare a 2-minute dance to share with our panel of judges. Please bring your music on a device we can connect to our speakers. During the group portion of your audition, we will watch to see how quickly you learn, your level of dance proficiency, how you work with other dancers and your respect for our Choreographer. Your solo presentation is your opportunity to show us that you can dance and communicate as a character. Have fun with this. Props or costume bits are welcome. 😊
